



During the October 20, 2011 Annual General meeting, former Colorado Rush standout, Todd Dunivant, was elected to the Rush Soccer Board of Directors. Dunivant, in his 9th year of Major League Soccer, and current member of the LA Galaxy, has had a successful professional career winning two MLS Cups and a Lamar Hunt U.S. Open Cup Championship. Over the years, Todd has earned the respect of his peers as he was one of four players elected to the Executive Board for the MLS Players Union.
