



Maryland Rush has entered into a partnership with Seneca Soccer Club (Rockville, MD) to provide technical expertise, playing opportunities and coaching clinics. This will increase the player pool for all Maryland Rush teams and help support the programs that Rush clubs in Region 1 are implementing. Seneca Soccer Club will now be known as Maryland Rush Montgomery. The 2 clubs will have a coaching staff that will work on player development, team development as well as overall club development. Teams compete against each other in a friendly format, as well as join together to participate in training sessions, getting specific training sessions from the top coaches in the country.
