



The W-League announced its Team of the Week for Week 2 of the 2012 season today, honoring Colorado Rush forward Danica Evans as Player of the Week. Evans, in her second season with the Rush, scored both game-winning goals as Colorado opened the 2012 season with a pair of 1-0 victories in British Columbia.

A member of the U.S. U17 Women's National Team, Evans scored both of her team's goals as the Rush moved to the top of the Western Conference standings with 1-0 victories at the Vancouver Whitecaps and Victoria Highlanders.
