



Colorado Rush alum Paolo DeIPiccolo has signed on to play with the Montreal Impact of the MLS! DeIPiccolo was drafted by the Impact in the 2013 MLS Superdraft (#27 overall out of the University of Louisville) but decided to first accept an offer to play with Eintracht Frankfurt in Germany. With the German season over, Paolo is back in North America and will begin playing with Montreal once his International Transfer Certificate clears the MLS.

"Paolo continues to represent the Rush on his soccer journey with absolute class," said Colorado Rush Technical Director Erik Bushey. "After experiencing a path less traveled by heading to Germany he has now signed on with MLS and is better for his experience. I continue to be proud of him and all he gives towards this great game."

Paolo will join fellow Colorado Rush alums Jeb Brovsky and Collen Warner with the Impact who currently sit atop the Eastern Conference with a record of 9-4-4 and 31 points. Only Real Salt Lake has a better record at this point in the season.
